### **Golf Outing**

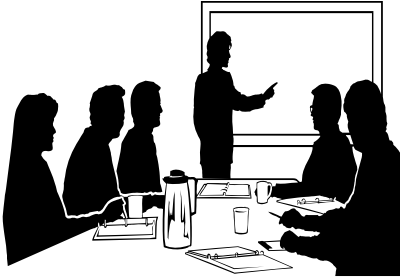
